

The Chair of Ontology and Theory of Knowledge (Department of Philosophy, Ural Institute of Humanities, Ural Federal University) took part in UNESCO World Logic Day 2021, which is celebrated annually on January, 14 and this year coincided with the 120th anniversary of Alfred Tarski's birth. To celebrate this event, the Chair organized an online panel discussion "Varieties of Logic: Outer Stimuli and Inner Resources".

The keynote was given by Alexey Kislov, the Head of the Chair of Ontology and the Theory of Knowledge, Department of Philosophy, Ural Institute of Humanities, Ural Federal University. The panel discussion was focused on a wide range of issues related to the varieties of logic, namely: historical variability and pluralism of conceptions of logical knowledge, deuniversalization of classical logic and proliferation of non-classical logical systems.

Among the participants of the panel discussion were experts from Ural Federal University, Institute of Philosophy and Law (Ural Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences), Institute of Philosophy and Law (Siberian Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences), Institute of Informatics Systems (Siberian Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences), and Innopolis University.
